### **THE GRANDIS** The tallest tree in NSW

A Flooded' gum (Eucalyptus Grandis) 84.3 metres high with a girth of 2.7 metres. It is estimated to be about 400 years old and would have been quite a large tree when Cook sailed up the nearby coast. There is an excellent viewing platform and picnic area. Enter from the Old Pacific Highway (Wotton Way) north of Bulahdelah along Stoney Creek Road. Access also from Lakes Way.



### **MOUNT ALUM**

The largest deposit of Alunite, in the southern hemisphere. Alunite is an industrial additive. Today small amounts of the white rock can be found on the bank of the Myall River when the ships were loaded. Mining ceased in 1952. Excellent park and picnic facilities, toilets, walking tracks and viewing platform. Enter the park from Church Street.



### **MYALL RIVER**

Meets with the Crawford River just up stream from the town bridge, giving Bulahdelah its name "meeting of the waters". The river flows down into the Myall Lakes offering boat access, fishing and the River Side Park.



### **MYALL LAKES**

One of the state's largest coastal lake systems a Ramsar Wetland of International Significance with 40 kilometres of beaches and rolling sand dunes. Myall Lakes one of the most visited parks in NSW. Camping, bush walks, boat ramps, fishing, available around the lakes. Access via Myall River by boat and Bombah Point Road by car. Take a ride on the Bombah Point Ferry to cross to the other side of the lake.



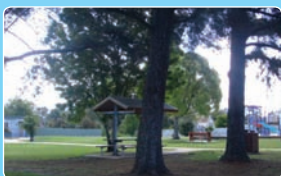
### **THE BIG BASS**

Carved from a single piece of local timber by Ray Towers and John Startin. This carving depicts the importance of the Australian Bass to our river and region. Have your photograph taken beside this big fish, the only one of its kind in Australia, maybe in the world!



### **BULAHDELAH COURTHOUSE & MUSEUM**

Built in 1886 from stone brought from England was in full use until 1956. Then used for various purposes before becoming a museum in the 1990's. Take a walk through history. Cnr of Anne and Crawford Streets. Open Saturdays 9am -3pm or by arrangement Tel 4997 4981



### **WADE PARK**

The most visited park in Great Lakes Region. Picnic and BBQ facilities, play equipment, disabled toilets, baby change, fresh water tap. Cnr of Meade and Crawford Streets. Open 24hrs 7 days a week.
